If you travel by Noida Metro, note, fast trains are coming, Metro will not stop at these 10 stations during peak hours 03.02.2021

Trains from terminal stations will be 'fast trains' from 8am to 11am and Monday to Friday from 5pm, which will not stop passengers at the 10 stations at this peak time.

To reduce passenger travel time on Noida Metro's Aqua Line Metro, Noida Metro Rail Corporation announced the launch of 'Fast Train' on Tuesday. These trains will not stop during peak hours i.e. when passengers are traveling on the metro, at stations where there is less ridership, i.e. from where fewer people have boarded the train. NMRC managing director Ritu Maheshwari said in a statement that the initiative would be launched in February.

The stations where these express trains will not stop during peak hours are Sector 50, Sector 101, Sector 81, Sector 83, Sector 143, Sector 144, Sector 145, Sector 146, Sector 147 and Sector 148 Metro Stations.

How much time will be left?

QR tickets will not be sold to passengers at these stations during the departure of these express trains. The NMRC chief said that the average run time of a single line from Sector 51 Metro Station to Greater Noida Depot Station is 45 minutes 43 seconds (one way) but due to fast trains running, this time will be reduced to 36 minutes 40 seconds, which is 9 for Aqua Line passengers. Will save minutes. At the same time, if you look at the run between Sector 51 Metro Station to Pari Chowk Metro Station, it is currently 37 minutes, with the arrival of the fast train it will be 28 minutes 30 seconds.

However, the frequency of trains will remain the same between Monday and Friday, with trains arriving at 7.5 minutes between peak hours and 10 minutes between non-peak hours. At the same time, on Saturdays and Sundays, trains will arrive at the Aqua Line at 15-minute intervals without any stations.

Efforts are underway to make passengers aware of the new system. Each metro station on the Aqua Line will run regular and fast train schedules and run information on which stations will be released. This will also be announced between trains and stations.
