

Noida-Greater Noida Expressway to be redeveloped! Check project details here

New Delhi: The 23 Km-long Noida-Greater Noida Expressway is all set to be redeveloped soon. The redevelopment project will use Bitumen technology and the whole expressway pay will be reconstructed after the elections are over. In order to improve connectivity with surrounding areas, the redeveloped expressway will have four underpasses. The work on the project is set to begin after the Moral Code of Conduct is lifted by the Election Commission. As per a recent *Dainik Jagran* report, the construction project is set to be complete by 2021. The expressway road will be constructed using bitumen technology for which a survey has already been conducted by construction companies. Since bitumen uses old material, the budget from this project will be low.

Check out the details of the project.

1. The first underpass will be constructed using box pushing technology for the first 2.36 Km. A budget of Rs 97.67 crore has been set for the project and it is estimated to be complete by December next year. The tender for this underpass is in process currently.
2. The second underpass is proposed for the first 19.4 Km and it will cost around Rs 45.4 crore. The work on this underpass is targetted to be complete March 2021.
