NMRC Updates Leasing Policy for Kiosks and Vending Machines to Support Women, Differently-Abled Individuals, and Startups

1. Update on Policy for Kiosks and Vending Machines.

Noida Metro Rail Corporation (NMRC) has updated its short-term leasing policy to promote inclusivity and to support entrepreneurship at its metro stations.

The short-term kiosk policy was launched in December 2024, which provided small business spaces-including kiosks, vending machines, ATMs, and innovative micro-business formats-across all 21 metro stations. These spaces, up to 10 square meters, are allocated on a *first-come, first-served* basis and aim to support startups, first-time business owners, and aspiring entrepreneurs.

Since its introduction, NMRC has successfully allotted kiosks vending machine spaces under this initiative.

To further boost participation from underrepresented groups, NMRC **has now relaxed the rental and solvency certificate requirements** for stations categorized under Band 2 and Band 3. This change is specifically designed to ease access for:

- Women entrepreneurs
- Differently-abled individuals
- Transgender persons
- Registered startup companies

The revised rental rates for these categories as under: -

For availing the benefit, the participants must submit the following certificate in addition to the existing document as per policy.

Category	Certificate
For people with disability	Disability Certificate issued by Government Chief Medical Officer, Disability Certificate/UDID Card issued electronically. Any respective Medical boards constituted at a State or district levels authorised to issue disability certificate
Transgender	Certificate issued by the District Magistrate or certificate issued by Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment
Women NGO entrepreneurs	Certificate issued by the state government's department or ministry related to women's development, entrepreneurship, or MSMEs (Micro, Small, and Medium Enterprises), as well as organizations like NITI Aayog's Women Entrepreneurship Platform (WEP).
Single Women entrepreneurs	Self-declaration by the first-time entrepreneur
Registered Startup company	Certificate issued by the Department of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT)
