## INTRODUCING FACILITY OF SMART CARD RECHARGE AT ALL TICKET VENDING MACHINES AT NMRC THROUGH UPI PAYMENT

Noida Metro Rail Corporation (NMRC) continues its commitment to passenger convenience and digital innovation. Following the successful launch of QR code ticket purchases through Ticket Vending Machines (TVMs) across 21 NMRC stations in November 2024, NMRC has now further enhanced its ticketing services.

To facilitate hassle-free travel and promote digital transactions, NMRC has introduced through UPI payment smart card recharge facility at all Ticket Vending Machines and ticket counters. This move allows passengers to easily recharge their SBI co-branded NMRC travel cards using UPI payment mode at all TVMs also, reducing the need to wait in long queues and contributing to efficient crowd management.

Key highlights of the facility include:

- Smart card recharge via UPI now available at all TVMs and ticket counters.
- Minimum recharge amount is ₹100, and subsequent recharges can be made in multiples of ₹100.
- The maximum permissible recharge limit is ₹2000 per transaction, in accordance with RBI guidelines.
- Card balance enquiry can also be done through the Ticket Vending Machines.
